\* THE HOLIDAY BEGINS, JULY 2

On July 2, 1776, the Continental Congress at Philadelphia, with no dissenting votes, declared that the American colonies were henceforth free and independent states.

John Adams wrote to his wife, Abigail, that the second day of July would “be celebrated by succeeding generations as the great anniversary festival. It ought to be commemorated as the day of deliverance by acts of devotion to God Almighty. It ought to be solemnized with pomp and parade, with show, games, sports, guns, bells, bonfires and illuminations from one end of this continent to the other; from this time forward forever more.”

The written document we know as the Declaration of Independence was signed on July 4, 1776. It concluded with these words, “ And for support of this Declaration, with a firm reliance on the protection of divine Providence, we mutually pledge to each other our lives, our fortunes, and our sacred honor.”
